

Criterion for Inclusion on AIDS.gov Webinar Page

The goal of the AIDS.gov webinar page is to provide resources that can be used to educate the HIV community and the Federal workforce about current topics in HIV prevention, care and treatment and research.

The objectives of our webinar page are as follows:

- Promote Federally-sponsored webinars on HIV and infectious diseases, as well as non-Federal webinars on those topics
- Assist the HIV community to work towards identifying event dates that avoid overlap with previously scheduled key national HIV webinars
- Encourage our Federal and non-Federal partners to suggest webinars for inclusion and promotion
- Promote AIDS.gov's webinar page planning resources to site visitors
- Feature webinars with descriptive information and registration instructions
- Archive products (slides and audio files) from selected AIDS.gov-supported Federal webinars, as possible.

Subject to space availability and team capacity, we will add webinars to this page based on the following criteria:

The webinar is of national interest and addresses a central aspect of the collective response to the HIV epidemic and to the occurrence of viral hepatitis, both domestically and internationally.

If it is a Federal event, the roster of speakers and moderators includes 1) Senior U.S. Government leaders who play key roles in the Federal response to the HIV epidemic, and/or 2) AIDS.gov team members as presenters or organizers.

If it is a non-Federal event, the webinar is sponsored by national recognized community leadership/organization and/or grantees that are also partners of OHAIDP and/or AIDS.gov.

The webinar does not advocate a particular political position or encourage political advocacy, and the subject matter is presented in scientifically and medically accurate ways.

The webinar does not include a request for fundraising.

The webinar's content will be of long-term interest to the HIV community.

The webinar is open to the general public at no cost, or, is a Federal training center webinar offered at nominal cost.
